1. Serving: Breweries donate all beer and Bite volunteers pour beer at event (- we promise). A representative of the Brewery will be present at the Bite to talk about their beers. Wineries supply their own servers as required by OLCC. Washington Wineries are required to have a representative present at the event to oversee volunteer servers.
2. Insurance: Wineries list as *Additionally Insured* on liquor liability insurance, for Bite of the Gorge, April 11, 2009:
 - 1) Columbia Gorge Arts in Education
 - 2) Western Antique Aeroplane and Automobile Museum
 - 3) WAAAM Board
 - 4) and, Terry Brandt.

Please fax or mail a copy of the insurance to AIE by **February 19th, 2010**. Fax number is 541-386-7198.

3. Wineries may sell bottles that must remain unopened at event.
4. AIE will sell drink tickets at event so wineries and breweries are not required to handle drink sales. Wineries may receive checks or cash for bottles sold. Checks should be made out to *Columbia Gorge Arts in Education*.
5. All Wineries registered in Oregon invoice AIE for wholesale value of the product consumed or sold, less a \$250 donation (for Oregon Wineries) or less a \$175 donation (for Washington Wineries).
6. Please make check payable to Columbia Gorge Arts in Education and include it with your paperwork due on **February 19th, 2010**.
7. Wineries obtain a special event license from OLCC for \$10. You can download a license application on our website at cgiae.org.
8. ** Oregon Wineries must send OLCC License, copy of "Additionally Insured", Application and Check payable to OLCC **to AIE** by **February 19th, 2010** for sign-off by Hood River County.
